**Space is limited, so you'll want to return your registration immediately! Registration deadline is May 15, 2009!**

In order to provide the best possible program, we must limit the number of participants. The best way to ensure your child's spot is to volunteer and to return the registration immediately.

**First consideration is given to children/grandchildren of adult volunteers.**

To get the fun going, we need **many** volunteers:

\* Some help in setting up, decorating and planning prior to the "big week".

\* Many serve as Crew Leaders, steering a Bayou Crew through activities.

\* Help is also needed for clean-up and in our nursery.

\*\* High School volunteers are encouraged to help, especially to aid Crew Leaders.

All High School and adult volunteers are expected to attend a planning meeting on **Monday, April 27, at 7:00pm in the St. Mary's Room.**

Every camper is assigned to a Bayou Crew.

Crews are groups of approximately five children with a volunteer leader.

Preschool Bayou Crews (ages 3 to 5) will participate in age appropriate programming, while school aged crews will be grouped in older and younger crews.

After the opening Sing and Play, every crew moves to the Bayou Stations where fun and learning occur.

At the end of each day, all will assemble for the Firefly Finale.

**Middle School volunteers (Gr. 6-7-8 in 09-10) will be assigned as aides.**

**FEES:** Preschool through Grade 5 - \$35 per child - \$100 family maximum  
Non-parishioners - Add \$10 per family  
**Registrations will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis.**  
**All registrations must be received by May 15, 2009.**

**TO REGISTER:**

- Complete the registration form
- Attach a check (made out to "St. Mary of the Assumption")
- Return registration to the Parish Office  
Indicate "**Church Camp**" on the envelope.

**IF YOU ARE UNABLE TO VOLUNTEER,** return the registration immediately.

We will attempt to place all children as forms are received.

Those who are unable to volunteer their time will be asked to donate specific food or other items.

**IF WE ARE UNABLE TO PLACE YOUR CHILD,** we will notify you as soon as possible. If you register on time and you do not hear from us to the contrary, you may assume that your child has been placed and plan to pick up your Family Packet.

**FAMILY PACKETS**

Every family participating in Church Camp will receive a bag of gear:

\*Bayou Crew Members and 5 day volunteers receive a Camp Tee shirt

\*Each family receives a Sing and Play music CD.

Pick up your gear prior to the beginning of camp.

**Family packets will be available in the parish Library after all Masses on the weekend of July 4/5 & 11/12.** If you are away during these weekends, perhaps you could ask a friend to pick up your family materials.
